### **DREAM NOTES CH 2-2.2 NUMBER:-**

# <u>NUMBER</u>

The next property to consider while studying ism is its Number. In terms of number there are three types of Ism, which are,

- وَاحِدٌ (1) Singular (1)
- مُثَنَّى (2) Dual (2
- عَمْعُ (+3) Plural (3

Lets discuss these individually.

#### 1) SINGULAR:-

The words are by default singular وَاحِدٌ and only when something is added to them do they change their number for example مُسْلِمٌ كِتَابٌ

#### 2) DUAL :-

In the Arabic language there is a distinct group of Isms categorised as Dual because they are used for 2 people which are called مُثْنَى . In order to make a singular Ism Dual we add اَنُنِ or اَنُونِ or كَانُتُ For example,

- a) In Raf' Status we add آنِ eg. From مُسْلِمَ to مُسْلِمَةُ from مُسْلِمَاتٌ to مُسْلِمَاتٌ

## 3) <u>PLURAL :-</u>

Plural Isms are more comprehensive than the other two types based on Numbers. There are different categories which we will see below,

#### a) Sound Masculine Plural (Muslim Chart)

مُسْلِمُوْنَ / مُسْلِمِيْنَ to مُسْلِمُوْنَ / مُسْلِمُ

### b) Sound Feminine Plural (Muslim Chart)

مُسْلِمَاتٌ / مُسْلِمَاتٍ to مُسْلِمَاتٌ مُسْلِمَاتً

### c) Non-Human Sound Feminine Plural

آيات \ آيات و to آيةً

other examples are ، سَمَاو اتٌ ، ثَمَرَ اتٌ ، سَيِّئاتٌ ، بَيِّناتٌ etc.

These isms are treated both as plural feminine PF as well as singular feminine SF

### d) Plural by Meaning (Ism Jama')

Isms which although are singular but point towards a group are known as collective nouns. In the Quran they are treated as Plural Masculine PM

#### e) Broken Plurals :-

These are plurals that don't follow the Muslim Chart and there is no definite rules as to how to form them except for certain patterns which one needs to remember. The original makeup of the word gets broken. There are two types of Broken Plurals which are,

### • Human Broken Plurals (جمع مكسر عاقل)

Three beings are treated as عاقل those having self consciousness and they are Human beings, the Angels and the Jinns For example From رُسُلٌ to رُسُلٌ . These Isms can be treated as both Singular Feminine SF as well as Plural Masculine PM.

## Non Human Broken Plural (جمع مكسر غير عاقل)

These plurals are of غير عاقل Isms, those that have no self-consciousness. These plurals are treated grammatically as SINGULAR FEMININE (SF)

- Broken plurals don't end in ending combinations so they look similar to singular isms
- Broken plurals may either be fully flexible or partly flexible

#### Lesson 5

#### – Number

In Arabic,  $_{\hspace{-0.5em}\text{\tiny low}}$  are of three types in regards to number:

- واجدٌ (wahid) Singular, indicating one.
- 2. نظی (muthan-naa) Dual, indicating two.
- 3. پخخ (jam') Plural, indicating more than two.

#### Dual – مُثَنَّى

The على (dual) is formed by putting a Fatha ( $\circ$ ) on the last letter of the الما and add ( $\circ$ ) at the end of the الما (Same rule is applied to both masculine and feminine ما ( $\circ$ ).

#### Plural - جمع

Plurals are of two types:

1. جع مکتر (Jam' Mukas-sar) – broken plural.

ي سام 2. (Jam' Salim) – sound plural.

#### (broken plural) – جمع مکسّر

اسم in which the form of the singular اسم in which the form of the singular اسم is broken, that is, changed. It has no fixed rules for making . حمد حكتر. Sometimes letters are added or deleted and sometimes there is merely a change in the Harakat.

In English we have broken plurals too, some examples:
