To get Males  
attention (pointing  
far)

ذَلِكَ - that (eg: pointing at a male and you want one male's attention)

ذَانِكَ – both of those (eg: point at two males and you want one male's attention)

أُولَئِكَ – those people (eg: pointing at people and you want one male's attention).

To get Females  
attention (pointing  
far)

Second part of the word ( لِكَ ) is only telling you whose attention you want.

ذَلِكَ – that (eg: pointing at a male and you want one female's attention).

ذَانِكَ - both of those (eg: pointing at two males and you want one female's attention).

الأسماء الموصولة		
الَّذِينَ (m) those who	الَّذَانِ (m) the two who	الَّذِي (m) the one who
الَّتِي (f) الَّوَاتِي الَّائِي the women who	الَّتَانِ the two who (f)	الَّتِي the one who (f)
مَنْ (m) who		مَا what (m/f)

### Notes:

الَّذِي can take a **فِعْل**

(on its own is a sentence a) and turn it into a fragment

نَصَرَ he helped (sentence)

يَنْصُرُ he helps (sentence)

Describing a person

الَّذِي نَصَرَ the one who helped (not a sentence)

الَّذِي يَنْصُرُ the one who helps (not a sentence)

صَاةُ الِ اسْمٌ مَوْصُولٌ

مَوْصُولٌ

الَّذِي is not a doer because نَصَرَ is not a sentence. You don't translate نَصَرَ as "he helped" when it's with الَّذِي you translate as "the one who helped".
