**Note:** Partly flex comparative can be made fully flex by showing a kasrah in جَرّ form by two ways.

- 1) by adding ال
- 2) by making it a مُضَاف

**Note:** every اسم that rhymes with أَكْبَرُ can only be 3 things.

- 1) comparative
- 2) color
- 3) disability

You can make them superlative eg: happiest, tallest, biggest

Partly flex comparatives

Two ways to make it superlative

1. comparative with ال is partly flex.

superlative with ال is fully flex. No

tanween.

With comparative meaning changes, goes from comparative to superlative. from “better” to “best” one way to do it is put ال on it, becomes superlative. And if it serves as mudaf.

A partly flex can become fully flex by adding ال but you don't put all on a name.

2. if it serves as mudaf, its superlative and fully flex.

و is cousins with damma

ى is cousins with kasrah
