1. إِنَّ – certainly
2. كَأَنَّ – as though (analogy)
3. لَيْتَ – regret (refers to the past)
4. أَنَّ – that (I thought that) clarifier
5. بِأَنَّ – because (لِأَنَّ not in the quran)
6. لَكِنَّ – however (لَكِنَّ harf of nothing, doesnt impact)
7. لَعَلَّ – maybe so that, hopefully

Note: لَعَلَّكُمْ تَتَّقُونَ have taqwa

Hopefully, maybe, so that (hon)

Note: Allah says about fasting:

It was made mandatory on you just like it was made mandatory on believers that came a long time before you and then he said

لَعَلَّكُمْ تَتَّقُونَ (not guaranteed)

not لِتَتَّقُوا (لِ – light harf present tense-“so that”

Just because you fast its not guaranteed you’ll become god conscious – hopefully, maybe

Note: أَنْ لَهُمْ أَجْرًا

“that a reward is for them”
